Jesus Teaches about the Sabbath based on Mark 2:23–3:6

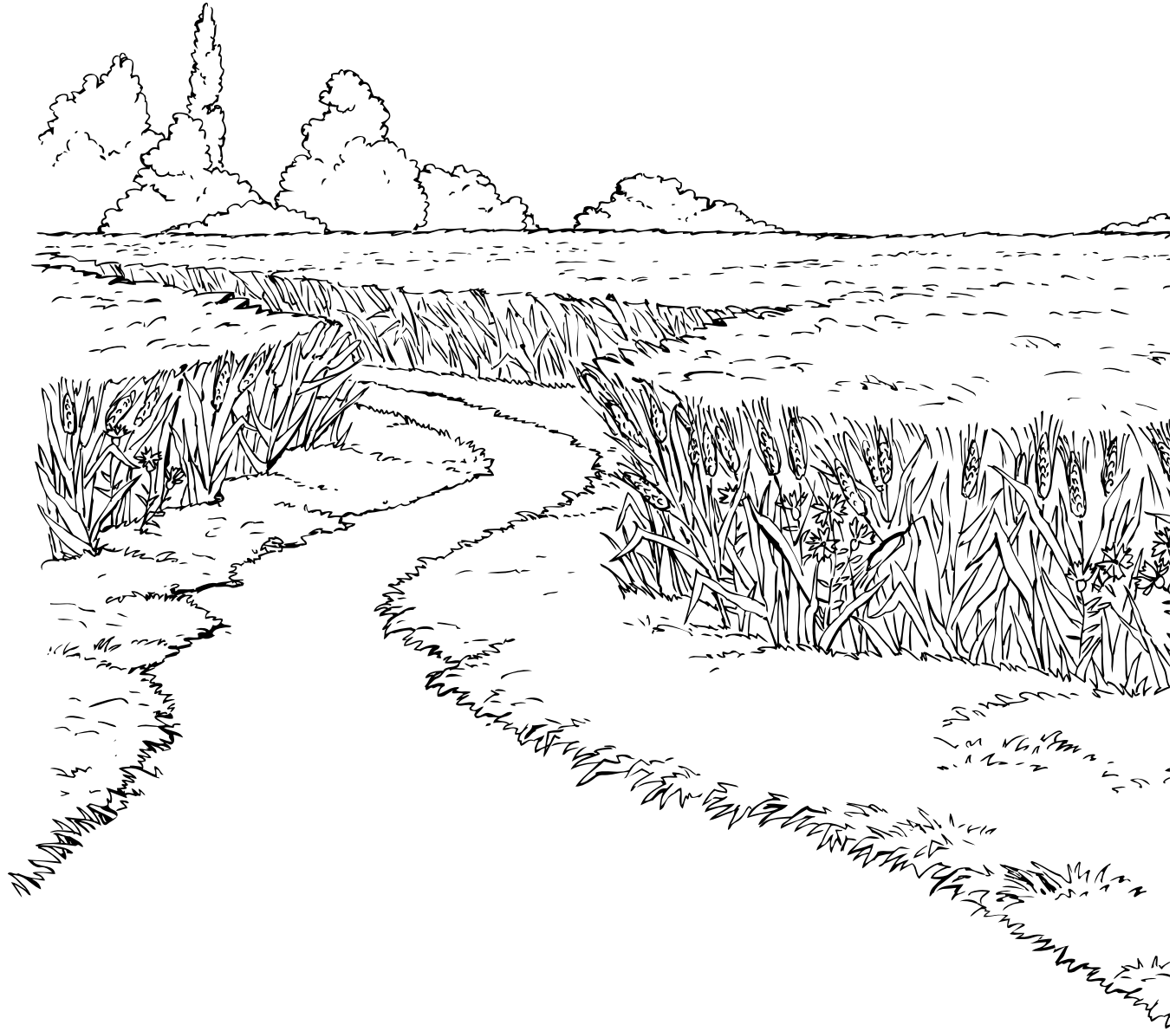
